THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Wednesday, June 21: St. Aloysius Gonzaga, religious(+1591). He was from the princely family of Castiglione and had been a page at the court of the Medicis and of Philip II of Spain. He renounced his inheritance to enter the Jesuits. Robert Bellarmine was his spiritual director. He was strongly devoted to the Eucharist, interior prayer, and charitable service; he died as a Jesuit scholastic at the age of 23 while caring for the sick. He is the patron of youth and of students in Jesuit colleges and universities.

Friday, June 23: The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, in late seventeenth-century France, had a vision of the Sacred Heart of Jesus – a sign of Jesus' mercy and love for all humanity. The devotion was officially recognized in 1765.

NOTE: This is the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests.
