### This Week at Mass

**Monday, July 24:** St. Sharbel Malkhluf, priest (+ 1898). He became a monk of the Maronite Rite and was ordained a priest, and spent the last 23 years of his life as a hermit. He possessed the gift of performing miracles even during his lifetime. He is known as the "Hermit of Lebanon."

**Tuesday, July 25:** St. James, the Apostle. He was the brother of John and is called "the Greater" because he followed Christ before the other apostle of the same name. He was the first of the Twelve to be martyred, being decapitated by the order of Herod Agrippa around 44. He is venerated in a special way at Compostella, Spain and is the patron of pilgrims, Spain, Guatemala and Nicaragua.

**Wednesday, July 26:** Sts. Joachim and Anne, parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Names for the parents of Mary were found in the second century *Protoevangelium of James*. Veneration of Anne originated in the sixth century East; she is the patroness of childless couples, women and miners. Devotion to Joachim dates from the eighth century.
