THIS WEEK AT MASS

Monday, August 28: St. Augustine, bishop, doctor of the Church (+ 432). Born in Tagaste, north Africa. After a dissolute life, he received baptism at the age of 33 from St. Ambrose. He was elected the bishop of Hippo, combated various heresies, and is most noted for his *Confessions and City of God*. He is considered as the founder of monastic life in the west. He is one of the four great doctors of the Latin Church, and is called the "Doctor of grace."

Tuesday, August 29: The Passion of St. John the Baptist. Today's memorial originates in the celebration of the dedication perhaps on this day of the church of St. John at Sebaste (Samaria) where, according to tradition, John the Baptist was buried by his disciples.
