## THIS WEEK AT MASS

**Monday through Wednesday** are weekdays during Ordinary Time with no feast or memorial of saints.

**Thursday, November 9:** Today marks the anniversary of the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome, on land owned by the Laterani family, by Pope St. Sylvester I in 324. This church is honored as the episcopal seat of the pope as the bishop of Rome. This has been the site of five ecumenical councils and the present structure was commissioned in 1646.

**Friday, November 10:** St. Leo the Great, pope, doctor of the Church (+461). He was an eminent pastor and preacher and defender of the Roman primacy. He combated early heresies. Many of his prayers are still found in the *Roman Missal*. He saved Rome from the marauding Huns and Vandals.

## NOVEMBER: ALL SOULS

November is traditionally known as the Month of All Souls. It begins with the feast of All Saints on November 1, and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls) on November 2. ### WORLD DAY OF THE POOR – NOVEMBER 19

Pope Francis has asked all Catholics to observe November 19 as a "World Day of the Poor." In our country, it's the Sunday before Thanksgiving. At the suggestion of program directors of the Cape Cod (and Island) Council of Churches, on November 18-19, we will be accepting donations of:

- warm jackets for adults and for children (sized 24 months, 2T and up)
  - hats, gloves, and scarves, especially for children. (all children's sizes).
- These can be newly purchased or gently used-not gift-wrapped.

They'll be used at A Baby Center (Hyannis), Hands of Hope (Harwich), and Youth Street Reach, for Saint Joseph House (Hyannis shelter run by our diocese).
