### THIS WEEK AT MASS

**Monday, May 21:** Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church. See elsewhere in the bulletin for more about this new feast in honor of Mary established by Pope Francis.

**Tuesday, May 22:** St. Rita of Cascia, religious (+1457). Born in Umbria, she lived with a brutal husband and had two sons. After the brutal murder of her husband she urged forgiveness rather than vengeance. She became an Augustinian nun and spent 40 years in prayer, contemplation, and service to the sick and poor. She is the patron saint of those in desperate situations.

**Friday, May 25:** St. Bede the Venerable, Priest, Doctor of the Church (+535). A Benedictine, he became known as the "Father of English history." Pope Francis has decreed a new Feast Day to the Universal Calendar. The world will mark the Feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary, "Mother of the Church" on the Monday after Pentecost each year. This year the feast will be celebrated on Monday, May 21.
