THIS WEEK AT MASS

Tuesday, June 5: St. Boniface, bishop, martyr (+754). He was an Anglo-Saxon Benedictine monk who founded the abbey of Fulda. He became the bishop of Mainz and was martyred along with thirty companions at Dokkum in Frisia. He is known as the "Apostle of Germany."

Wednesday, June 6: St. Norbert, bishop (+1134). In 1120 he founded the Canons Regular of Prémontré (known as the Premonstratensians or Norbertines), which today number some 1,250 members. He was the archbishop of Magdeburg and a strong supporter of Church reform and evangelization. He had a special devotion to the Holy Eucharist.

Friday, June 8: The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, in late seventeenth-century France, had a vision of the Sacred Heart of Jesus – a sign of Jesus' mercy and love for all humanity. The devotion was officially recognized in 1765.
