### THIS WEEK AT MASS

**Monday, June 11:** St. Barnabas, apostle (+ 1<sup>st</sup> century). He preached the gospel in Antioch and was a companion of St. Paul. He attended the Council of Jerusalem and was martyred on the island of his birth, Cyprus. He is patron of Cyprus.

**Wednesday, June 13:** St. Anthony of Padua, priest, doctor of the Church (+1231). A Franciscan from Lisbon, he was devoted to scripture. He was the first friar to teach theology to his fellow friars. He was such a gifted orator and preacher that he became known as the "Evangelical Doctor." He is the patron of Portugal, of the poor, of harvests, and of lost articles. We honor him and show our devotion to him with a statue in our church.
