### THIS WEEK AT MASS

**Thursday, June 21:** St. Aloysius Gonzaga, religious(+1591). He was from the princely family of Castiglione and had been a page at the court of the Medicis and of Philip II of Spain. He renounced his inheritance to enter the Jesuits. Robert Bellarmine was his spiritual director. He was strongly devoted to the Eucharist, interior prayer, and charitable service; he died as a Jesuit scholastic at the age of 23 while caring for the sick. He is the patron of youth and of students in Jesuit colleges and universities.

Today let us remember the wonderful Jesuit priests from Boston College and the College of the Holy Cross who assist us at various times, but especially in the summer.
