THIS WEEK AT MASS

Wednesday, June 27: St. Cyril of Alexandria, bishop and doctor of the Church (+444). Defended Mary at "God bearer" at the Council of Ephesus (431) against the Nestorians. He was a spokesperson for orthodoxy noted especially for his Christological formulations. He supported the growth of Egyptian monasticism.

Thursday, June 28: St. Irenaeus, bishop, martyr(+c.202). He was the first to provide a coherent rationale for a Christian Bible including both testaments, and the first to offer a comprehensive account of belief in God's universal providential and redemptive economy. He was a disciple of Polycarp and was the bishop of Lyons for 25 years. He wrote against the Gnostic heresy.

Friday, June 29: Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. Peter (+ c. 64 in Rome under Nero) had been a Galilean fisherman who became the spokesman for the Twelve and eventually the "Prince of the Apostles."

Paul, according to tradition, was martyred in Rome c. 67. He was a Pharisee who became the "Apostle of the Gentiles."
