Holy Week begins today. We begin by waving palms singing "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" We join with the crowds who welcomed Jesus

Diocese to Launch Eucharistic Revival

On June 18 The Diocese of Fall River will join dioceses across the country in launching a multi-year Eucharistic Revival this year on the weekend of the Feast of Corpus Christi. Save the date of Saturday, June 18, and plan to take part in a special Mass along with a Procession and Adoration at Bishop Connolly High School in Fall River, to begin at 4 p.m. Additional information will follow. Chrism Mass

On Tuesday of Holy Week, Bishop Edgar M. da Cunha, S.D.V., together with priests of the Diocese, will celebrate the annual Chrism Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral – a traditional Holy Week liturgy that includes the blessing of oils and the renewal of priestly promises. It will take place at 4 p.m. on Tuesday, April 12.

The Chrism Mass will be livestreamed on the diocesan [Facebook page](#). After the Mass, the oils are distributed to all parishes in the Diocese for their use throughout the year.

The Chrism Mass is also a time for priests in the presence of the bishop and the faithful to renew their commitment to the ministry to which they were ordained. Both diocesan and religious priests who reside and/or minister in the Diocese will take part. Bishop da Cunha will then ask the lay faithful present at the Mass to pray for their priests as well as for him in his service as diocesan bishop.

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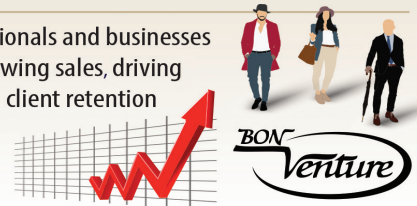
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
