Noting the Easter Season in Church and Liturgy Until Pentecost (June 5) the Easter Candle will be lit whenever we celebrate the Eucharist.

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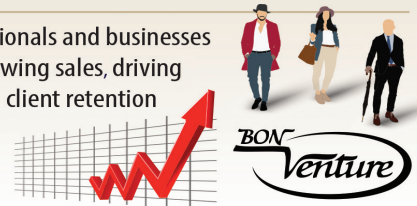
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
