I was so glad to have learned recently that I have been assigned to serve at St. Mary, Our Lady of the Isle Parish on Nantucket for the summer. As a seminarian, you can't help but wonder in anticipation as to where your first assignment as a priest will be. It is a blessing for me to be with all of you this summer!

As a child growing up, I never thought about a vocation to the priesthood at all. I grew up in Attleboro, MA and I lived in Franklin, MA prior to entering the seminary. After completing college and graduate school I worked as a psychotherapist with combat veterans who had served our country. As a young adult, I began to notice that many of the goals that I had set for myself that I thought were so important had not provided exactly what I thought they would. There was a part of myself that seemed unfulfilled.

This is what led to my openness to discern a vocation to the priesthood. Through time and prayer, I became increasingly convinced that this was what the Lord was calling me to do with my life. In 2016, I left my career and entered St. John's Seminary in Brighton, MA. I am so grateful to be a priest. One of the many gifts of priestly ordination is that you recognize that every moment of your life up until now has always been pointing to this moment, even when you weren't aware that this is what God had planned for you.

I look forward to the opportunity to pray with and for all of you this summer!

The rosary will be prayed every morning, Monday through Friday, at 7:10am before morning Mass.

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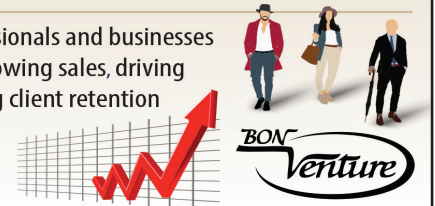


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
