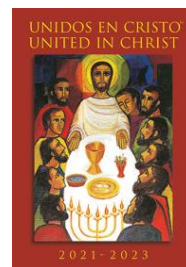

NOVEMBER: ALL SOULS

November is traditionally known as the Month of All Souls. It begins with the feast of All Saints on November 1, and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls) on November 2. All during the month at Mass we will remember our loved ones who have gone before us. "All Souls" envelopes will be in your budget envelope packet. Or there will be All Souls envelopes at the back of the church. Just list the names of those you would like to have remembered at Masses during the month of November. Names will be inscribed in a Book of Remembrance, which will be placed on the altar during Masses. Be sure to include your own name on the front of the envelope.
