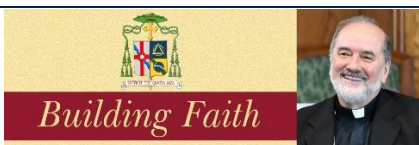


On Monday, January 16, along with the people of our country, we remember the birthday of Martin Luther King Jr. and his work to end racial discrimination.
