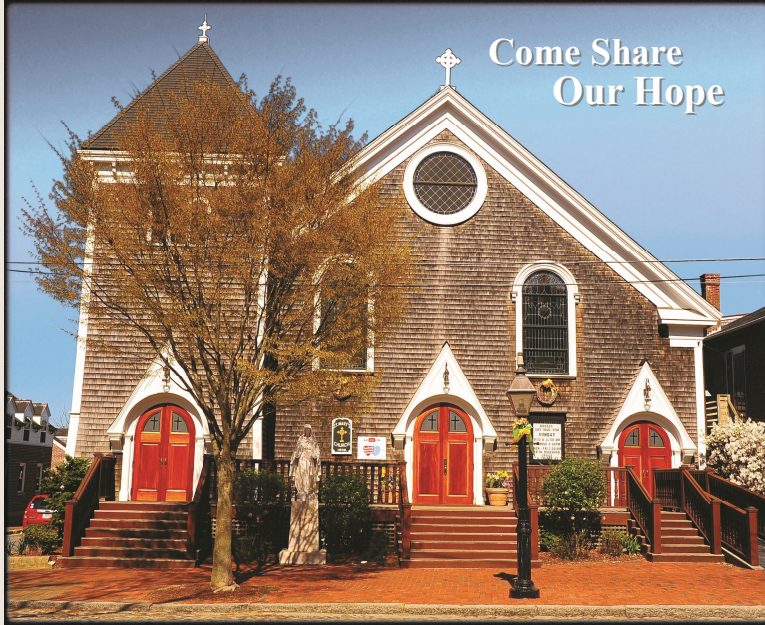

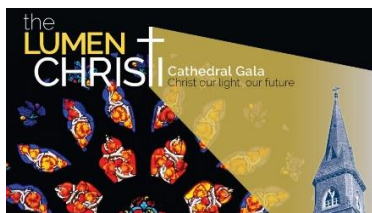

The restoration of St. Mary's Cathedral in Fall River is underway, and the second annual *Lumen Christi* Cathedral Gala set for next month aims

to raise funding to continue with the repair of this iconic 167-year-old structure.

The **Lumen Christi** Cathedral Gala will take place at 6 p.m., Wednesday, June 7, at White's of Westport, and its proceeds will help to finance the cost of critical repairs to the church in several areas including the Cathedral's masonry, roof, bell tower, and stained-glass windows. Thanks to the funds raised through the inaugural *Lumen Christi* Cathedral Gala held last year, work on the Cathedral has begun. A complete building scan of the Cathedral and Rectory existing conditions is being used to document and specify the restoration work and most immediate needs. The first of the 18 stained-glass windows lining the nave is currently being restored at New England Glass.

Lumen Christi, meaning 'Light of Christ,' captures the role that the Cathedral plays in the Diocese of Fall River. The Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption serves as the spiritual center of the Diocese, where its bishop has his chair, in Greek, *cathedra*, and where the Catholic community of Southeastern Massachusetts and Cape Cod and the Islands gathers with its bishop to celebrate significant diocesan liturgies and events.

The event also helps to shine a light on the many repairs needed at the Cathedral. St. Mary's was built over the years 1852-1855 with its steeple, which rises 195 feet into the Fall River skyline, completed three years later. Originally a parish church, it was designated a cathedral church upon the establishment of the Diocese of Fall River in 1904. A video of Dr. Richard Grace, historian and professor emeritus of history from Providence College, explains many significant elements of the Cathedral as well as areas in need of restoration. www.vimeo.com/cfsema/cathedraltour

We thank them and we praise God for their ministry.

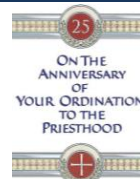
Until then, our regular schedule continues: Saturday at 5PM and Sunday at 8 and 11AM Spanish Mass at 6:00PM.

World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests – Friday, June 16

In 2002 Pope Saint John Paul II designated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus as the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. The USCCB states, "On this day, the Church encourages priests to prayerfully reflect upon the gift of their vocation. The faithful are also invited to mark this celebration by praying for all priests that they may live lives of holiness and fidelity to Christ and his Church." This year, the celebration occurs on Friday, June 16, 2023. The Diocese has asked the faithful of the Diocese to consider offering special prayers on that day for the sanctification of our priests. Below are a few examples:

- Attend Mass and offer the Mass for the sanctification of our priests
- Pray the Holy Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet for our priests
- Offer some sort of fasting for our priests on that day
- Pray devoutly just one Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory be for our priests

All are encouraged as well to pray the following prayer together for the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests: "May the Sacred Heart of Jesus, through the intercession of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, imbue all priests with His grace, strengthen their hearts, and renew them in their vocation to image Christ, Head and Shepherd, Servant and Spouse. Amen."
