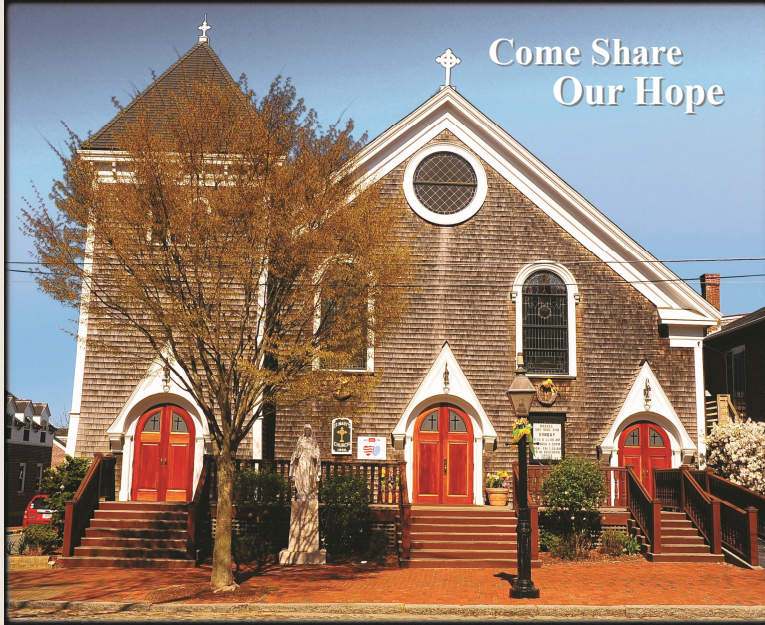

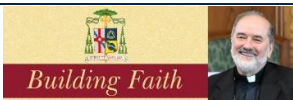
- Attend Mass and offer the Mass for the sanctification of our priests

Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate the great mystery of the Eucharist – The Solemnity of The Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This is the central mystery of our faith which makes us who we are. As the Body of Christ, we receive the Body of Christ in order to become more like the one

whom we receive and who ultimately receives us ever more deeply into the divine life.

We are truly privileged to share in this gift each week. It's here that we find meaning for our lives. It's here that we bring our sorrows and our joys; our hopes and our disappointments; and yes, our acts of righteousness and our sins. It is in the Body of Christ that we find the true meaning of discipleship and our lives.

This weekend is a particularly special one for me. It is on this feast 25 years ago that I celebrated my first Mass as a priest. The day before, on June 13, 1998, I was ordained a priest. I remember these two days clearly. I remember everyone who was there and celebrating with me and supporting me. In particular, my parents. They are the ones who passed the Catholic Faith on to my sisters and me. This faith is what eventually lead me to the priesthood – thanks be to God! The presence of my sisters, my brother-in-law and my nieces and nephews this weekend means more to me than I could ever express.

As I celebrate this feast and this anniversary with all of you, my parish family, I am mindful of the absence of my parents. Last year my Mom gave me a card for my anniversary; it was just about two months before she died. It's the last card my Mom ever gave me and I am thankful that I still have it. Among the things she wrote in the card is this "I hope I am here next year to celebrate your 25th!" While she and my Dad are not here physically, I know they are here spiritually, especially at Mass. I use the chalice they gave me for my ordination which connects me to them to be sure. But even more powerfully the altar and Mass are the doorway between Heaven and Earth; the place where the church triumphant and the church militant unite in a way that is beyond comprehension. In Christ we are all united; all divisions cease and He who is "the same yesterday, today and forever" holds us together as one in His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity – the Eucharist.

So this weekend we celebrate gifts; the Eucharist, the Priesthood and Family – for me these are intimately connected. I am truly a grateful man.

Please pray for Fr. Cody and his family this weekend as well. On June 5th he celebrated his 30th anniversary of priesthood. I am so grateful for his presence in our parish and am grateful he and I are able to share the priesthood together as brothers.

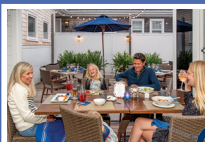
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
