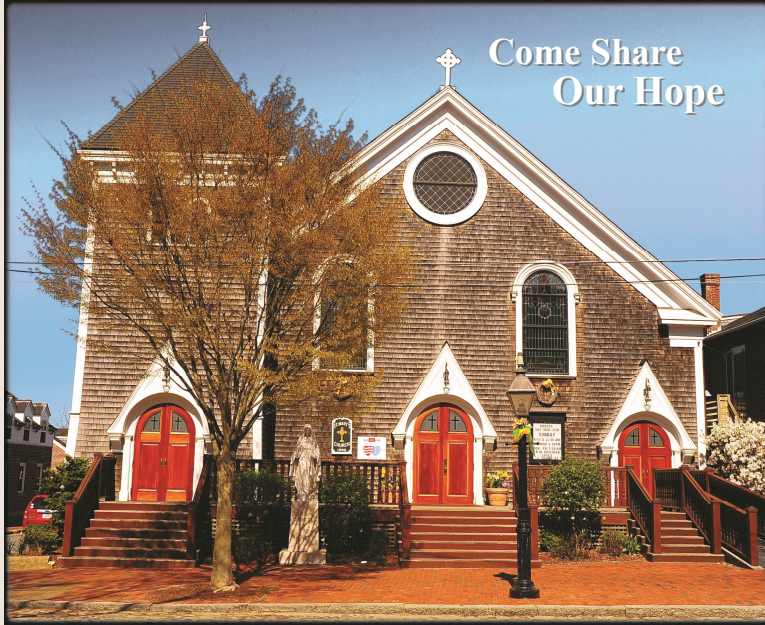

Dear Friends,

When I was a kid, a very long time ago, there was a public service announcement on television which tried to encourage people to be more polite and courteous to one another. It was in the late 70's or early 80's but I still remember the jingle "A little courtesy won't kill you". It was sung to a very catchy tune. However, the concept of courtesy didn't seem to quite catch back then and I don't think it has now. At least not on a grand scale.

Nowhere in the Bible does it say "be nice to each other". The main point of religion is not kindness and not every religion boils down to the same message of just being good to each other. We all seem to agree, however, that we should all be kind and polite to one another. So if we all agree on this as a concept, let's ask the question - how's that going for us as a culture?

Last Sunday at the 'Sconset Chapel several young men, caddies from Sankaty, came to Mass. Each of them entered church politely and respectfully. When I greeted them they were engaging, they shook my hand firmly and looked me right in the eye. They had a confidence about them but more importantly these young men wanted to instill in the person with whom they were engaging that he or she was important.

They were not looking at a mobile device nor were they wearing ear buds. They were present in the moment and to the person in front of them. This is what is missing in so many areas of our culture today.

I think we can learn a valuable lesson from these young men. Let's make a greater effort to extend that polite greeting; let's go out of our way to be courteous; let us be present to the person in front of us and let them know they are important.

After all, this is what Jesus did in His public ministry and it is what He did on the cross; He focused on you and me -- each one of us to let us know how important we are to Him and His Father.
