Dear Friends,

Last weekend, at the beginning of Mass, a few folks spoke about the need to update and renew our Church and the rectory. I am so very grateful for the leadership taken by parishioners who care about our parish. People saw a need, brought it to my attention and are now not only helping me address it but are also guiding the process to make it easier to accomplish. I am so very grateful for this.

Our Church, which is admittedly a lovely building, does need some "sprucing up". The carpet has seen better days; the pews are not the best, the lighting needs to be better, we need some paint and the windows need to be addressed. That is just the interior. We also need some maintenance on the exterior.

The rectory is certainly another story. Not much has been done in many years to maintain the exterior. We have wood that is rotting, paint that is peeling and windows that need to be replaced. We also have to look at the interior. I've told our "crew" that I am not looking to get the rectory on a house tour or featured in a magazine; that would certainly not be appropriate. But we need to look at plumbing, electric, paint, lighting, etc... As anyone who has ever done work on their home knows, once you start, other unexpected needs become apparent.

I am grateful to be your pastor and love being here on Nantucket. It will be two years on August 21 and I can say that I feel very much at home here and want that to be the case for as long as God (and the bishop) allows!

We will be asking for your assistance in many ways. Some will be able to make financial contributions. Others who have skills in the various trades - building, carpentry, electric, painting, etc. can contribute in that way. We are a parish family and a family works together. More info will be forthcoming. In the meantime, let's all continue to pray for one another. I pray for you all daily.

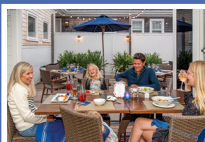
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
