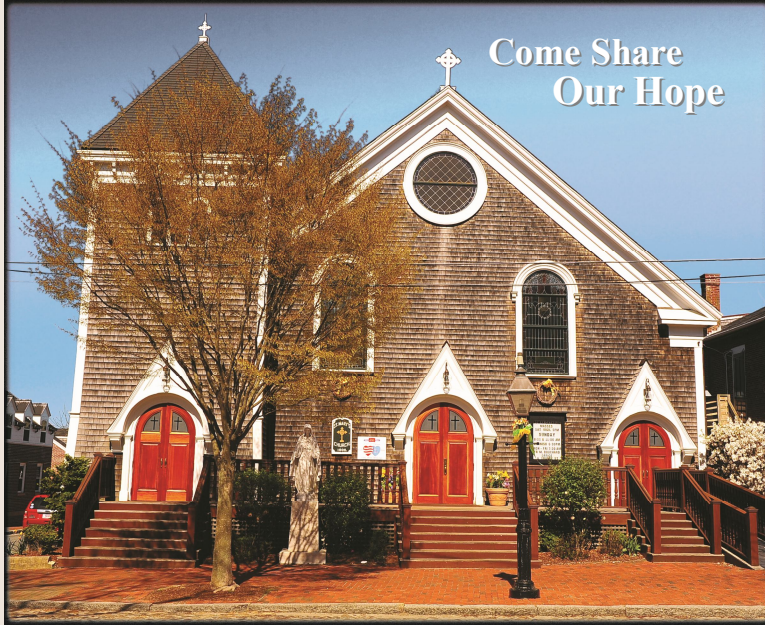

Dear Friends,

This weekend is Catechetical Sunday; the day on which we are reminded of the importance of the catechesis -- the handing on of our Catholic Faith -- to the children of our parish.

This is done in several

ways. The first is through our Faith Formation Program. Judy DeBaggis is our Director of Faith Formation for the English Speaking population of our Parish and Ceci Gutierrez has the same role for the Spanish Speaking Population of our Parish. Ceci and Judy, along with a team of dedicated teachers, gather with the young people of our parish each week to hand on to them the beauty of the Catholic Faith.

This is not the only way Catechesis happens. Parents are the first and most important teachers of their children in our Catholic Faith. The family plays a more than significant role in this; their role is primary.

The best "Faith Formation Program" we have is Sunday Mass. It is here that we encounter Jesus Christ, our God, Shepherd and Teacher. In His Eucharistic Presence we learn more about Him than what is contained in books or in classrooms.

The role of our Faith Formation Program, while important, is supplemental and presumes that parents and families are already teaching their children in the ways of faith and coming to Mass together.

As a Parish we need to support our families as well as our Parish Faith Formation Program. We need to encourage parents and families to come to Mass together and be examples of our Catholic Faith to the young people and young families of our Parish. Catechesis is the responsibility of every Catholic, not just to the "brave souls" who teach in the program.

Let us pray for our Catechists and the young people and families of our Parish. Let us all grow in faith and holiness together.

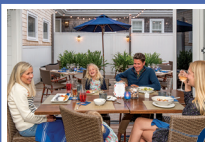
