THIS WEEK AT MASS

The first eight days of the Easter Season make up the octave of Easter and are celebrated as solemnities of the Lord. The wonder of Easter is too great to be captured in one day or one Mass. So this whole week of Easter can be considered as one great Easter Sunday during which we celebrate again and again the wondrous joy of the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. We also celebrate our share in this life stronger than death and more powerful than sin by virtue of our baptism. The Easter season continues for 50 days, culminating with the Feast of Pentecost (May 19). During this time the Easter candle or "Pascal" candle will be lit each time we gather for Mass.

Christ is risen! He is truly risen! On this day, and for the next 50 days, we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The powers of this world, the powers of evil, sin and death, took everything they had and threw it all at Jesus. It killed him, to be sure. He died. He was placed in the tomb. This is Easter! He is risen! He is truly risen! Amen and Alleluia!
