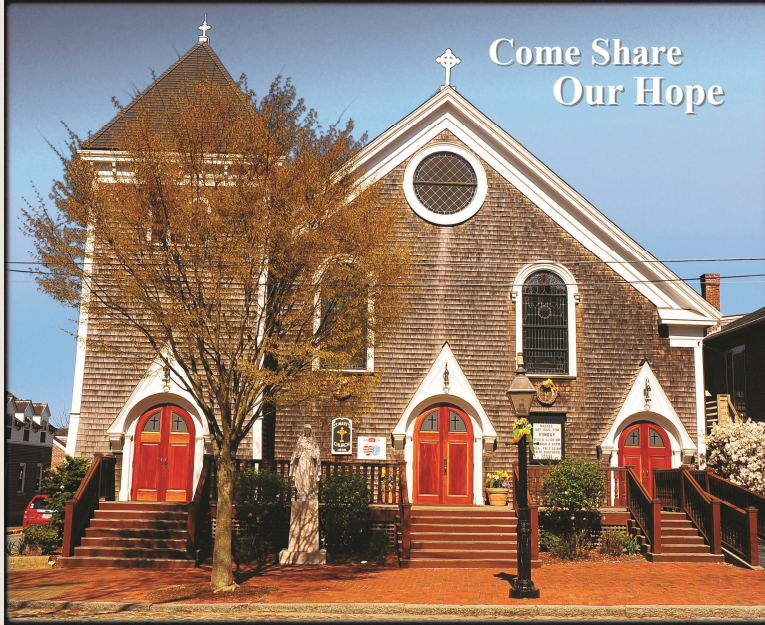

of our parish. She received the award with the youth of other parishes of our diocese in the context of a 7 p.m. prayer service on Monday, May 6, at St. Mary's Cathedral in Fall River.

The annual award, named for the pontiff who created the Fall River Diocese in 1904 and presented for the first time in 2001, recognizes teens who serve their parish community with selflessness, commitment and dedication. The award itself is a medal bearing an image of St. Pius X along with his motto, "Restore all things in Christ."

We congratulate Yuliana and thank her for her service to our parish especially in our Hispanic community where she stands out for her spirituality and for working with children and young people. Yuliana's is the daughter of Julio Cesar and Delmi Mariyel Rivera.

Finally, because there will be meetings throughout the year, we will need members of the Council who live here throughout the year. It's just easier and more practical.

Members of the Council will be from among the Spanish and English speaking parishioners. I want to have the proper representation of the diversity of our Parish Community.
