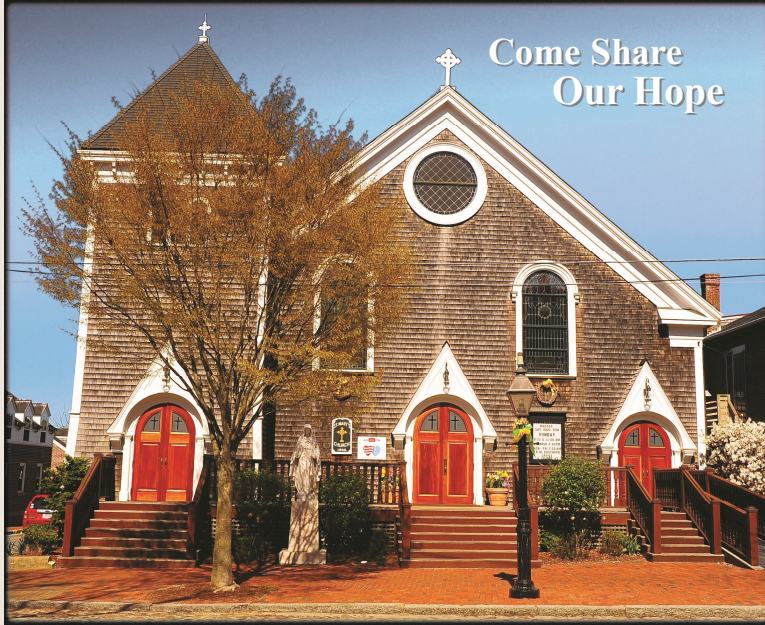

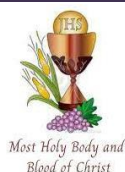

Dear Friends,

This weekend is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi -- The Most Holy Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ; a long title of a solemnity for a great mystery.

The Eucharist, which is described so beautifully by the

Second Vatican Council and the Catechism of The Catholic Church, is "the source and summit of the Christian life." Let's unpack that brief little segment of a sentence.

The Eucharist is the source of the Christian life; meaning it is the very beginning of the Christian life; it is that from which Christian life originates. How can this little white piece of bread and a bit of wine be the source of all of this? Because the Eucharist is Christ Himself. Jesus Christ gives Himself fully to us in the species of bread and wine, no longer bread and no longer wine. But they maintain all the looks and properties of both. There is a new reality present; Jesus Christ Himself - The Way, The Truth, The Life. He is the Eucharist; therefore, He is the source.

The Eucharist the Summit of the Christian Life. What does this mean? While we receive from the Eucharist the beginning of our life as disciples so we find the highest point of our life as disciples of Jesus Christ. He is the origin and the goal (and everything in between). Worthy celebration and reception of the Eucharist is essential in order to be true disciples of Jesus. It's really Him. In one tiny, seemingly insignificant white piece of bread there is the fullness of Jesus Christ -- Body and Blood Soul and Divinity. The same is true of the little bit of wine in the chalice. Both contain the fullness of the reality. Each Mass should be the most transformative moment of our lives.

The great priest, St. Jean Vianney, once said, "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." And he said this, "If we truly understood the Eucharist we would die of joy." Amen!

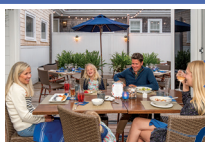
