Dear Friends,

On June 11th the Church celebrated the Memorial of St. Barnabas. St. Barnabas is one of my favorite saints and the reason is because of his name. His name means "son of encouragement". I believe that encapsulates one of the primary ways of life of a Christian, to encourage one another in faith.

There is also another reason why I love St. Barnabas and his memorial; it's because of the first reading of Mass that day from The Acts of The Apostles. Chapter 11, verse 6 of Acts tells us that "It was in Antioch that the disciples were first called Christians." This means that there was something about their identity and way of life that caused people to start calling the disciples Christians. What was it?

The word Christian comes from the Greek word "Christianos" - which simply means follower of Christ or one who belongs to Christ. This begs the age old question of Shakespeare from Romeo and Juliet. "What's in a name?" Well, everything! To be a Christian means that we must truly belong to and follow Jesus.

Here's the challenge; do we really belong to Jesus? Do we truly follow him? Do we live differently than those who are not Christians? Is there something noticeable in the way we live, the way we talk, the way we act and the way we love that is different from those who do not follow Jesus? There should be!

Yes, 2000 years ago the disciples were first called Christian in Antioch because there was something that made it noticeable that they were following Jesus. When was the last time someone recognized us as followers of Jesus? When did someone last call you or me a Christian?
