Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate Pentecost. We call this the Birthday of The Church as it was the day, 50 days after Easter, on which The Father and The Son sent The Holy Spirit upon the Apostles to begin the life and work of the Church.

The first reading from The Acts of The Apostles, shows the unity the Spirit brings. All were gathered in Jerusalem; there were people there from different countries, speaking different languages. Yet when the Apostles began to preach everyone understood them as if they were speaking to them directly in their own native language.

This first reading shows the restoration brought about by the Paschal Mystery (the death and resurrection of Jesus) and the sending forth of the Holy Spirit. Recall the story of the Tower of Babel; humanity trying to build an edifice so high that it would reach Heaven - humanity attempting to get to heaven, and God Himself, without the assistance of God – this is arrogance and pride. God scattered humanity by creating a division of language so they would not understand one another and thus not be able to continue engaging in this work of arrogance.

Pentecost is the solution, the remedy. The Holy Spirit unites us in God and draws us to God, to Heaven. We are not doing this on our own. By the power of the Sacraments we are infused with the life of God and we are now able to be drawn to Him as He brings us to Himself, not us trying to bring Him to ourselves or to bring ourselves to Him without His Heavenly Aid.

May the Holy Spirit heal us of all wounds of sin and division and may the Church be the sign of unity among a wounded and divided humanity. Come Holy Spirit!

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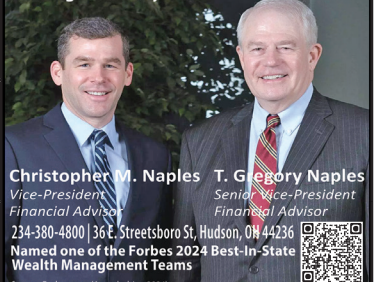
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
