Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate Holy Trinity Sunday. We reflect upon the greatest mystery of our faith; God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Three distinct persons, one God. The Athanasian Creed expresses it this way:

“That we worship one God in trinity and the trinity in unity, neither blending their persons nor dividing their essence. For the person of the Father is a distinct person, the person of the Son is another, and that of the Holy Spirit still another. But the divinity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one their glory equal, their majesty coeternal.”

While St. Athanasius expressed with great precision and clarity, it is still hard for us to comprehend this Divine Reality. Yet, as challenging as it is to comprehend, it is a mystery that is closer to us than we are to ourselves. We are created in God's very image. Therefore, by our creation and our redemption, we have the Trinity dwelling within us. In particular, Baptism gives us the fullness of the indwelling of God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Recall last week's message about the Church, which is the dwelling place of God in the Spirit. If this is true for the Church, then it is true for us. Yes, The Trinity is a mystery, but one that dwells within us, as well as in Heaven. The life of the Trinity gives us the ability to live out our vocations; the call to holiness, marriage, religious life, holy orders, and so forth. But first and foremost it is that universal call to holiness which is the primary vocation of every Christian.

Speaking of vocations, this past Friday I celebrated 27 years as a priest. There is no way in God's creation that I would be a priest without having first been baptized and confirmed; that is, without the life of the Trinity within me. The Trinity makes every life, every vocation possible. This is true for me, for you and for every human person, and especially for the disciples of Jesus Christ.

Let us share this profound unity and community of Persons (The Trinity) with everyone whom we encounter. God bless you all!
