Dear Friends,

This week we come to the marvelous celebration of Corpus Christi; The Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This is a core belief of our Catholic Faith. The bread and wine, at Mass, undergo transubstantiation thus becoming the Holy Eucharist; the Body and Blood, Soul and

Divinity of Jesus Christ Himself. In a word — the fullness of Jesus Christ present as He is in eternity, including his humanity. This is what the bread and wine become and this is who we receive. It is no longer proper to speak of the Eucharistic species, after the consecration, as bread and wine as they have been changed at their substantial level into Christ Himself. In each species of the Eucharist, the fullness of Christ is present. There is no distinction other than appearance.

As we celebrate this feast we encounter Melchizedek in our first reading. His encounter with Abram is a blessing for Abram, soon to become Abraham; and this encounter is also a prefiguring of Christ Himself. Melchizedek, we are told, is the King of Salem, the King of Peace. He also offers bread and wine to show the blessing he is offering to Abram. This prefigures the Eucharist. Melchizedek is a priest of God Most High; prefiguring the priesthood of Jesus.

In the Old Testament, the Jewish Priesthood didn't come into existence until after the Exodus and Passover. Melchizedek, historically, predates all of this. Thus showing that the priesthood in which he shared does not depend on inheritance (as the priesthood of Aaron did) but is given by God Himself. There are only two other times when Melchizedek appears in Scripture. He is mentioned in Psalm 110 and in The Letter to The Hebrews, chapter 7. While he is mentioned only three times, he is essential to the understanding of the priesthood of Jesus Christ, the Eucharist and the ministerial priesthood in the Catholic Church. On this feast let us honor who we receive, from whom we receive it, and who we become in receiving Christ's Body and Blood Soul and Divinity.
