Dear Friends,

I have to admit I was very excited last weekend in anticipation of this weekend. I was really looking forward to getting back into green vestments for Sunday Mass (yes, these are the things I look forward to!). However, here we

are this weekend celebrating Saints Peter and Paul — no green vestments for Sunday yet! Red vestments are the order of the day because both of these great saints and apostles were martyrs; Peter was crucified, upside down, and Paul was beheaded.

Ordinarily Feast Days do not take precedence over a Sunday, but this one does due to who it is we are celebrating.

Peter — the rock. The one on whom Jesus built His Church; it was Peter's confession of faith and his leadership, our first pope, which gives him this place of honor.

Paul — at first, as Saul, was the great persecutor of the Church. His zeal for his Jewish Faith caused him to see the followers of Jesus as a problem which needed to be eradicated. Jesus took that passion and zeal and converted Paul to become the greatest of evangelizers. Paul's letters alone make up 13 of the 27 books of the New Testament. His contribution to the understanding of the Church is something we will rely on today.

So, red vestments it is; we are grateful to God for these two extraordinary men and from their place in Heaven they continue to pray for us.
