THIS WEEK AT MASS

Wednesday, July 9: St. Augustine Zhao Rong, priest and companions, martyrs. The 120 martyrs honored today died between 1648 and 1930. Most of them (87) were born in China and were children, parents, catechists, or laborers, ranging from nine years of age to seventy-two. This group included four Chinese priests. The thirty-three foreign-born martyrs were mostly priests or women religious, especially from the Order of Preachers (Dominicans), the Paris Foreign Mission Society, the Friars Minor (Franciscans), Jesuits, Salesians, and Franciscan Missionaries of Mary. Augustine Zhao Rong was a soldier so moved by the martyrdom of a bishop that he converted and eventually was ordained a priest, then martyred. They were all canonized in 2000.

Friday, July 11: St. Benedict, abbot (+547). He wrote the famous Monastic Rule, noted for its wisdom, moderation, and need for obedience. He founded 12 monasteries including Monte Casino. Benedictines today number 7,600 religious. Considered the "Patriarch of Western Monasticism," he is also a patron of Europe.

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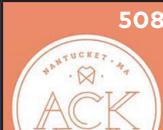
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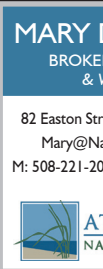
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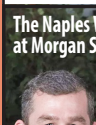
