THIS WEEK AT MASS

Tuesday, July 22: St. Mary Magdalene. Healed of possession, she became a disciple of Jesus and was present at His crucifixion. In the gospel of Mark she is the first to witness to the risen Lord, and so called the apostle of the Apostles. She has been mistakenly identified as the sinful woman of Luke 7: 36-50. She is the patroness of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans).

Thursday, July 24 St. Sharbel Makhluf, priest (+ 1898). Born in 1829 in a small mountain village, he became a monk of the Maronite Rite and was ordained a priest in 1859. Devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary, he spent the last 23 years of his life as a hermit. He possessed the gift of performing miracles even during his lifetime. His tomb at the monastery of St. Maron in Annaya, Lebanon is a place of pilgrimage. Canonized by Pope Paul VI in 1977, he is known as the "Hermit of Lebanon."

Friday, July 25: St. James, the Apostle. He was the brother of John and is called "the Greater" because he followed Christ before the other apostle of the same name. He was the first of the Twelve to be martyred, being decapitated by the order of Herod Agrippa around 44. He is venerated in a special way at Compostella, Spain and is the patron of pilgrims, Spain, Guatemala and Nicaragua.

Dear Friends,

Hospitality is an essential aspect of our lives as disciples of Jesus Christ. In fact, this extends back to our Jewish roots as we see in the first reading this week from Genesis.

Abraham sees three travelers approaching. They have no need to ask him for

hospitality because as soon as he sees them he asks the favor of them to please allow him the privilege of extending them hospitality. "Let me bring water for your feet; let me feed you, rest under this tree. Enjoy its shade." Abraham sees this as his honor and privilege, not an obligation or a burden.

The Letter to The Hebrews reminds us that we must not neglect showing hospitality. Some, in showing hospitality, have entertained angels. Where are the opportunities in our lives where we can show hospitality? These opportunities could be as obvious as welcoming friends and family to our homes. But there are other, not so obvious, opportunities.

Here are some suggestions: being the best family member we can be; loving your spouse, your children, your siblings — putting them first; welcoming visitors to Nantucket; being kind and helpful. Offering to move out of the way as a family is taking up the entire sidewalk (we have all seen this!). Helping people we encounter on a daily basis with a burden they might be carrying; buying someone a meal or a cup of coffee; talking to the stranger; offering directions to someone and letting someone cut into traffic ahead of you. These are so simple and they are certainly not an exhaustive list. But they are at least a beginning.

Friends, this isn't just about being good and kind people. The hospitality we are called to offer is a sharing in, and reflection of, the very hospitality of God extended toward us. Abraham knew this because of the covenant which God established with him and his descendants. He experienced it first hand, and so have we. In Baptism, in the Eucharist, in the very life, death and resurrection of Jesus, we have experienced the radical hospitality of God offered to us.

Let us be like Abraham and consider it a privilege to welcome others into our lives. We never know when the one whom we are welcoming is God in disguise.

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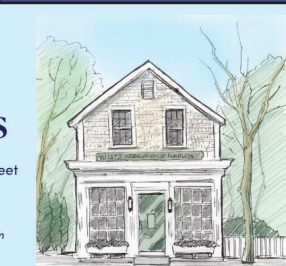
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
