THIS WEEK AT MASS

Monday, June 1: St. Justin, martyr (+165). He was martyred under Marcus Aurelius. He was a layman and an apologist who gave one of the earliest descriptions of the Mass. He is the patron of philosophers and apologists.

Tuesday, June 2: St. Marcellinus, priest, and St. Peter, exorcist, martyrs (+303). They were beheaded under Diocletian. Both were so important to the time that their names have been preserved in the Roman Canon (First Eucharistic Prayer).

Wednesday, June 3: St. Charles Lwanga and companions, martyrs (+ November 15, 1885 to January 27, 1887). They are the proto-martyrs of Black Africa. During this period over one hundred were killed, including Anglicans. Charles is the patron saint of African Catholic Youth Action.

Friday, June 5: St. Boniface, bishop, martyr (+754). He was an Anglo-Saxon Benedictine monk who founded the abbey of Fulda. He became the bishop of Mainz and was martyred along with thirty companions at Dokkum in Frisia. He is known as the "Apostle of Germany."

Feast of Corpus Christi

Next weekend is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi.

Bishop da Cunha sends the following message to the parishes of his diocese.

In June the consecration of our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and

the arrival of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage to our diocese are reasons for us to celebrate.

The words of the Sequence for this Solemnity remind us that in this glorious Sacrament:

"Blood is poured and flesh is broken, yet in either wondrous token Christ entire we know to be. 'Whoso of this food partakes, does not rend the Lord nor breaks; Christ is whole to all that taste'"

In the Holy Eucharist, our Blessed Lord gives his very own flesh and blood "for the life of the world." What a wonderful mystery! Each of us, unworthy though we are, is invited to receive, become and communicate this gift.

In receiving the most precious Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord, we are strengthened to imitate his sacrifice by making our lives a gift to others.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ this year, I ask you all to prayerfully give of yourselves by:

- * Joining in the prayer for the consecration of our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, (You can also watch the livestream of the official consecration by the Bishops on Thursday, June 11, at 4:00 PM at the USCCB website),

- * Praying for vocations and for the newly ordained in our diocese, and

- * By participating in the events of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage taking place in our diocese in Easton, New Bedford and Fall River on June 29-30 to whatever degree they are able. The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will be taking place this June in honor of America's 250th Anniversary, concurrent with the U.S. Bishop's consecration of our country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The pilgrimage will process the Eucharist from St. Augustine Florida, traveling through the original 13 colonies, to its eventual conclusion in Philadelphia Pennsylvania on July 4th. The pilgrimage will travel through our own diocese Monday, June 29th through Tuesday, June 30th. Opportunities to take part in the pilgrimage through Mass, Eucharistic processions, and Adoration will take place in Easton, New Bedford, and Fall River. 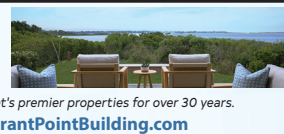

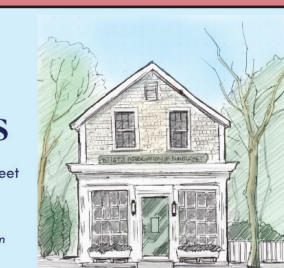
