Consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus June 11, 2026

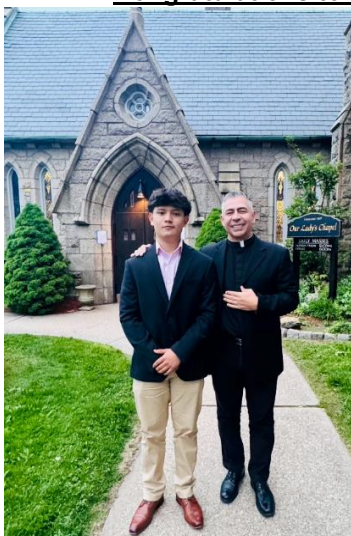

THIS WEEK AT MASS

Tuesday, June 9: St. Ephrem, Deacon, Doctor of the Church (+ 373). He was a Syrian theologian and poet who authored biblical commentaries, homilies, and composed hymns. He founded a theological school at Nisbis (modern Turkey) and lived in Edessa (in Mesopotamia).

Thursday, June 11: St. Barnabas, apostle (+ 1st century). He preached the gospel in Antioch and was a companion of St. Paul. He attended the Council of Jerusalem and was martyred on the island of his birth, Cyprus. He is patron of Cyprus.

Friday, June 12: The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, in late seventeenth-century France, had a vision of the Sacred Heart of Jesus – a sign of Jesus' mercy and love for all humanity. The devotion was officially recognized in 1765.

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi.

Bishop da Cunha asks that as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ this year, ask you all to prayerfully give of yourselves by:

* Joining in the prayer for the consecration of our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, (You can also watch the livestream of the official consecration by the Bishops on Thursday, June 11, at 4:00 PM at the USCCB website),

* Praying for vocations and for the newly ordained in our diocese, and

* By participating in the events of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage taking place in our diocese in Easton, New Bedford and Fall River on June 29-30 to whatever degree they are able. Taken from the letter from Most Reverend Edgar M. da Cunha, S.D.V., D.D., regarding the Feast of Corpus Christi

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will be taking place this June in honor of America's 250th Anniversary, concurrent with the U.S. Bishop's consecration of our country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The pilgrimage will process the Eucharist from St. Augustine Florida, traveling through the original 13 colonies, to its eventual conclusion in Philadelphia Pennsylvania on July 4th. The pilgrimage will travel through our own diocese Monday, June 29th through Tuesday, June 30th. Opportunities to take part in the pilgrimage through Mass, Eucharistic processions, and Adoration will take place in Easton, New Bedford, and Fall River. 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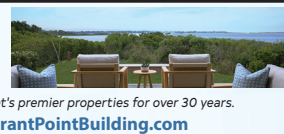
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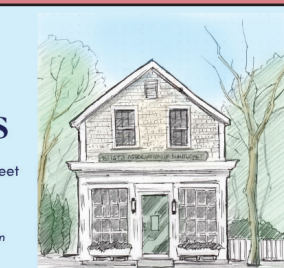
