Friday, May 27: St. Augustine of Canterbury, bishop (+ 604). He was a monk in Rome, sent with forty other monks by Pope Gregory I to England. In 601 he became the archbishop Primate of England.

Pentecost – The End of the Easter Season

Note these changes as of the end of the Easter Season with Pentecost last Sunday:

- We have begun "Ordinary Time" – not "usual" or regular – but numbered weeks until Advent.
- Sunday Mass will once again begin with the **Penitential Act**, rather than the Rite of Sprinkling.
- We will return to the use of the **Nicene Creed**.
- **The Easter Candle**, will return to its usual place near the baptismal font. It will be lit for baptisms and funerals.
- **The expanded baptismal font** will be returned to storage until next Easter.
