THIS WEEK AT MASS

Monday, May 30: Memorial Day. We will remember all our loved ones who have gone before us, those who have died in wars defending the values we hold so dear, and all veterans. We will celebrate the Mass "For Peace and Justice." See above for cemetery prayers.

Tuesday, May 31: The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We celebrate that hospitality and affection with which Elizabeth, pregnant with her son, John the Baptist, greets her cousin Mary, the bearer of the Mighty Savior, Emmanuel (God is with us).

Wednesday, June 1: St. Justin, martyr (+ 165). He gave us one of the earliest descriptions of the Mass.

Thursday, June 2: St. Marcellinus, priest, and St. Peter, exorcist, martyrs (+303). They were beheaded under Diocletian.

Friday, June 3: The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, in late seventeenth-century France, had a vision of the Sacred Heart of Jesus – a sign of Jesus' mercy and love for all humanity. The devotion was officially recognized in 1765.
