THIS WEEK AT MASS

Tuesday, June 21: St. Aloysius Gonzaga, religious(+1591). He renounced his inheritance to enter the Jesuits. Robert Bellarmine was his spiritual director. He is the patron of youth and of students in Jesuit colleges and universities.

Wednesday, June 22: John Fisher, bishop and martyr and Thomas More, martyr (1535). John had been the chancellor of Cambridge University and bishop of Rochester; he was renowned for preaching and educational reforms. Thomas was a humanist and the chancellor of England. They refused to support Henry VIII's divorce of Queen Catherine and his Act of Supremacy.

Friday, June 24: The Nativity of John the Baptist. The Church celebrates only three births during the liturgical year: that of Jesus, Mary, and John the Baptist. This feast came to be celebrated in accord with Luke 1:36, six months before the Lord's birth.
