THIS WEEK AT MASS

Tuesday, June 28: St. Irenaeus, bishop, martyr (+ c.202). He was the first to provide a coherent rationale for a Christian Bible including both testaments.

Wednesday, June 29: Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. Peter (+ c. 64 in Rome under Nero) had been a Galilean fisherman who became the spokesman for the Twelve and eventually the "Prince of the Apostles." Paul, according to tradition, was martyred in Rome c. 67. He was a Pharisee who became the "Apostle of the Gentiles."

Thursday, June 30: The First Holy Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church. Those many Christians who were tortured, crucified, and burned alive in 64 in Nero's garden on the Vatican Hill are honored today.

Friday, July 1: St. Junipero Serra, priest (+ 1784). From Petra, Majorca, Spain, a Franciscan missionary who arrived in New Spain in 1750 and established nine of the California missions.
