THIS WEEK AT MASS

Monday, July 11: St. Benedict, abbot (+547). He wrote the famous monastic Rule, noted for its wisdom, moderation, and need for obedience. **Wednesday, July 13:** St. Henry II, (+ 1024). Together with his wife, St. Cunegunda, he assisted the poor; as emperor, he respected the Church's freedom, fostering ecclesiastical and monastic reform.

Thursday, July 14: St. Kateri Tekakwitha, virgin (+ 1680). She died at Caughnawaga, Québec at the age of 24. Called "Lily of the Mohawks," she is the first native American to be declared "blessed." She was canonized in 2012.

Friday, July 15: St. Bonaventure, bishop, doctor of the Church (+ 1274). A Franciscan, he was the minister general of the community for 17 years.
