IMPORTANT CORI NEWS
FOR
ALL PARISH STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS

Since the inception of the new branch of the Diocesan Office of Safe Environment last year, new standards and regulations for CORI have been set in place. This past year was a “period of grace” so that the required guidelines could be implemented uniformly by all parishes in the Diocese.

Beginning with THIS year’s CORI renewals, we must comply with all the standards expected. ALL Parish Staff Members and Volunteers MUST participate in this process.

The process involves completing and returning:
1) the CORI Acknowledgement form;
2) a copy of a MA driver’s license or a passport; and 3) a signed Pastoral Code of Conduct. (only return the signature page).
In addition, you are required to complete the on-line CMG Connect training, and **4) include the completed training certificate with your other three CORI documents.**

Also, any Youth Volunteers, grades 9 through 12 must sign a **Youth Code of Conduct.**

All necessary forms are available on our Parish Website: stmarysnantucket.org
You may call our Faith Formation Office at 508-228-4852 or text Judy DeBaggis at 508-317-0155 with any questions.

The Diocese will be audited for compliance with these standards in September, so cooperation with this process is urgent. **We are asking that all forms be returned to our Parish Office by Friday, September 6th. For security reasons, our Diocese does not recommend emailing these documents.**

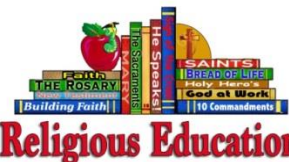
