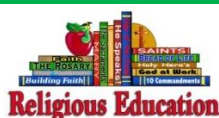

It is a joy to share God's word with the children and we would be happy to have you join us.

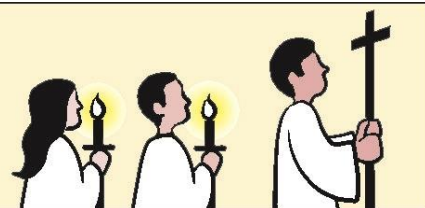
Ever think about attending weekday Mass?
