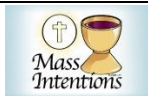
Ministry to the Sick: Please inform us of any sick relatives that they might be placed on our schedule for receiving Eucharist.

Letter from Fr. John June 2, 2020

Dear Friends in Christ,

I hope this note finds you well and staying healthy. As you may know, Bishop da Cunha gave permission for Churches in the Diocese of Fall River to reopen for public Masses during the weekend of May 30th / 31st. The first public Mass here at St. Mary's was the Vigil Mass of Pentecost on Saturday, May 30th at 5 p.m.

Please know that it is not "business as usual" with regard to public Masses. There are many guidelines and restrictions which must be followed if we are to keep everyone as safe as possible, including social distancing, the wearing of masks in the Church, and limiting the number of people who can safely enter the Church.

With more and more people coming to Nantucket from so many other locations, I am sorry to say that we will continue to keep our St. Mary's Church doors locked for the time being.

Given the fact that the Coronavirus can live on nonporous surfaces for days, this measure is for the safety of all who would be stopping in for prayer during the course of each day. Even if you are one of the many people who has a key to the Church and Parish Center, I urge you NOT to go inside. As a Faith Community, we must do all we can to prohibit the spread of this disease on our beloved Nantucket Island.

If you choose to come to Church for Mass, please assist us by cooperating with the guidelines and directives which have been issued by state and local officials, and by Bishop da Cunha. This is the only way to keep everyone as safe as possible during this time of pandemic. I do not want even ONE person to contract the virus because they came to St. Mary's Church.

Please be well and be safe, and may God bless you during this difficult time.

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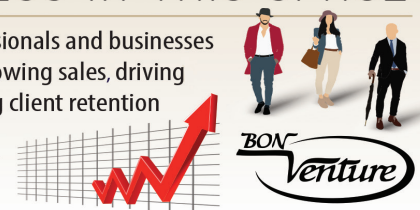
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
