Update on Sconset Chapel

It's been difficult to set a schedule for Masses at the Chapel this summer because things keep changing regarding their restrictions and guidelines. After speaking again with Fr. Carr Holland, the Episcopal Priest who administers the chapel, **this is what I know about Masses at Sconset Chapel this summer:**

Contrary to previous reports, **we will NOT be having a 4 p.m. Mass on Sundays out at Sconset.** Fr. Carr had SUGGESTED an afternoon Catholic Mass, in addition to the morning Mass, when the capacity for the Chapel was only 60 people. The capacity is now up to 100 people, and it's expected that a capacity limit for the Chapel will be lifted entirely AFTER the last weekend in June. So, **the only Mass at Sconset Chapel this summer will be at 8 a.m., and this will begin, as usual, on the last Sunday in June (June 27th).** Please note that the Mass is NOT being scheduled for 8:45 a.m. as it has been in the past because Fr. Carr still wants enough time for the Chapel to be sanitized before the Episcopalian Service at 10:30 a.m.

Also contrary to previous reports, **the Chapel has now decided NOT to use a reservation system for their services.**

Masks are still required of EVERYONE

attending Sconset Chapel services. This policy is an attempt to protect "vulnerable populations" like children or adults who have not been vaccinated, or who have other pre-existing medical conditions.

Social Distancing will still be required of everyone not from the same household during the Sconset Chapel Mass on Sunday, June 27th. After that weekend, it's expected that the Chapel will revert to full capacity and social distancing will not be required, but masks will still be required.

My advice regarding Sconset Chapel as summer approaches is to **keep an eye out for possible changes in policies or schedule!** Thank you.

The rosary will be prayed every morning, Monday through Friday, at 7:10am before morning Mass.

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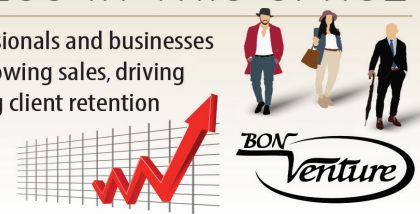
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
