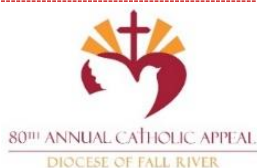

Update on Sconset Chapel

After speaking again with Fr. Carr Holland, the Episcopal Priest who administers the chapel, **this is what I know about Masses at Sconset Chapel this summer:**

Contrary to previous reports, **we will NOT be having a 4 p.m. Mass on Sundays out at Sconset**. Fr. Carr had SUGGESTED an afternoon Catholic Mass, in addition to the morning Mass, when the capacity for the Chapel was only 60 people. The capacity limit for the Chapel will be lifted entirely beginning this first weekend in July.

So, **the only Mass at Sconset Chapel this summer will be at 8 a.m., and this began, as usual, on the last Sunday in June (June 27th)**. Please note that the Mass is NOT being scheduled for 8:45 a.m. as it has been in the past because Fr. Carr still wants enough time for the Chapel to be sanitized before the Episcopal Service at 10:30 a.m.

Also contrary to previous reports, **the Chapel has now decided NOT to use a reservation system for their services.**

Masks are still required of EVERYONE attending Sconset Chapel services. This policy is an attempt to protect “vulnerable populations” like children or adults who have not been vaccinated, or who have other pre-existing medical conditions.

My advice regarding Sconset Chapel is to **keep an eye out for possible changes in policies or schedule!** Thank you.

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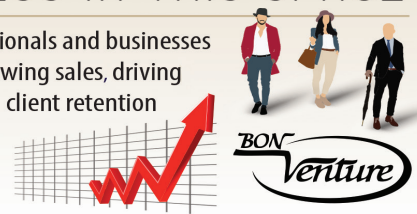
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
