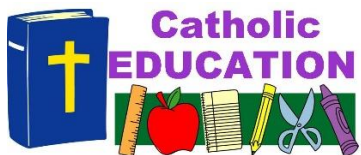

All first graders and any new students entering the program need to register. Registration can be done by emailing Judy DeBaggis at javeni@comcast.net or by calling her at 508-317-0155.

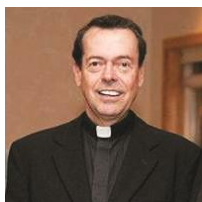
Class schedules and class location will be sent to registered students in September.

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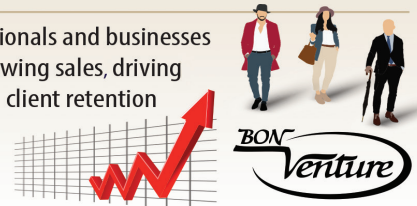
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
