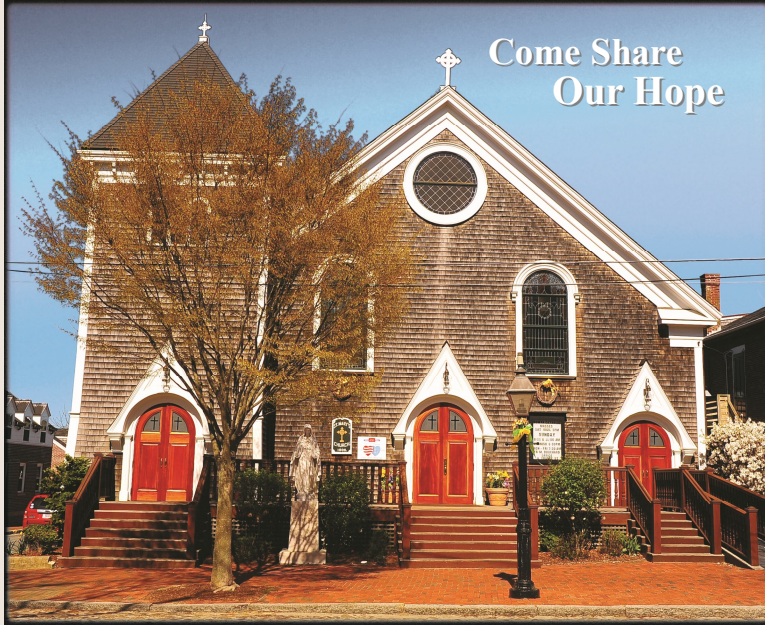

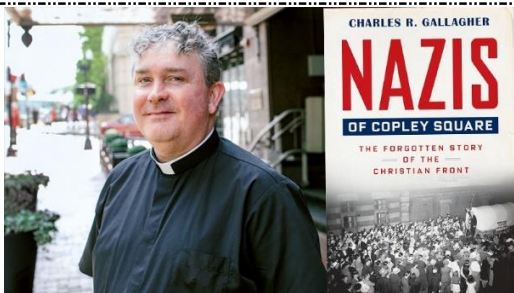

In "Nazis of Copley Square", Charles Gallagher provides a crucial missing chapter in the history of the American far right. A forgotten history of American terrorists who, in the name of God, conspired to overthrow the government and formed an alliance with Hitler.

Charles Gallagher, once a Nantucket police officer, is a Jesuit priest and Associate Professor of History at Boston College. His book Vatican Secret Diplomacy won the John Gilmary Shea Prize from the American Catholic Historical Association. He also occasionally officiates at St Mary's Church.

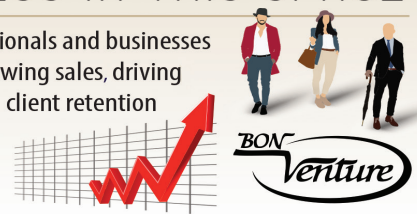
